

Urban University Gains Security from Access Control System

A local urban university was experiencing trespassers cutting through campus and disrupting classrooms. In addition, they needed to provide after hours security for their various student organizations and required that all buildings lock automatically.

To design a network based S2 access control solution to control access throughout the campus and to provide peace of mind that all buildings were secure.


Kansas City University of Medicine and Biosciences (KCUMB) is a private university comprised of a College of Osteopathic Medicine founded in 1916 and a College of Biosciences. KCUMB is the oldest medical school in Kansas City and is the largest in Missouri.

KCUMB's campus is like a jewel shining in the center of the city. However, with trespassers causing disruptions, and with the need to keep students safe after hours the university needed an access control system that easily merged with existing security; that is simple to utilize; and that is easy for students, faculty and staff to use.

Enter Kenton Brothers. We designed a complete S2 access control system to work with the existing security cameras, to be implemented and added to over time, and to be operated entirely from a web browser. The system uses a card credential for access because the users were already carrying a photo badge card. This made the transition to the access control application more familiar and less painful for the users since everyone was already used to carrying a card.
